We work across productions varying from High-End TV and features to low budget and shorts, with all jobs guaranteeing to pay at least National Minimum Wage. As part of the crewing service, we also offer crew bespoke tailored advice and guidance, as well as CV feedback. All elements of our service are completely free of charge, and we're always keen to promote new entrants and trainees to productions where we can.

Registration Requirements:

If you are based in England, outside London, then you can register. You will need to accept our T&C's and Privacy Policy and complete our Diversity & Inclusion Monitoring Form. For us, diversity and inclusion matter, so as part of the registration process, we kindly ask you to complete a confidential Diversity & Inclusion Monitoring Form. Your data is safe with us. This step is necessary before your profile goes live.



How to Register

Start your registration <u>here</u>. The process should only take a few minutes and you will be asked to fill in a number of sections about you, what job roles you are after, your experience, where you are based, where you are willing to work and contact details so we can make sure we can put you in touch with the right job when it comes along. You can add additional information like your CV, showreel, website, credits or affiliations and you have the choice on what personal information is made public and what is not.

After registering, your profile will need to be approved by our team, this should take no longer than 24 hours, but might take longer in busy periods. After that it will be live for productions to find you. You can update or amend your profile anytime you want by logging into your account <u>here</u>. If you no longer wish to receive crew calls or job opportunities you can delete your profile at any time by logging in.
